CAI uses state-of-the-art artificial intelligence (AI) to automatically score student writing with our Autoscore engine. CAI deploy their models to work alongside human scoring; unusual or borderline responses are routed to human scorers for verification scoring, and random subsets of responses are routed to human scorers as a quality check. Their approach helps to ensure that all responses receive valid and reliable scores and that scores are returned quickly to educators for use in the classroom.

CAI's AI models are the result of years of research and are grounded in long-standing educational measurement standards that have validity, reliability, and fairness of scores as key foci. These standards include the implementation of policies and procedures to ensure of AI models are developed and used in a responsible manner. Below, we describe how CAI's approach addresses each principle in the Blueprint for an AI Bill of Rights.

- Safe and Effective Systems. Automated scoring is a well-established practice in assessment, with accepted standards around its use, CAI adheres to these standards and implements checks throughout the deployment process to ensure that models are verified prior to use and monitored throughout their use. Psychometric reviews of models, technical documentation, and oversight by technical advisory committees occur regularly.
- Algorithmic Discrimination Protections. No information on students is used in the modelling process and CAI regularly examines whether the engine performs differently for students in protected classes. When training models, CAI ensures that the training sample represents the student population and the conditions under which students take tests. Additionally, the hand-scores on which the engine is trained are reviewed for accuracy, reliability, and bias.
- Data Privacy. Data used to train AI models have been approved for that use by our clients and adhere to federal privacy guidelines around security and privacy. All data, including the AI models themselves, are used solely for the delivery of assessments on behalf of our clients. Additionally, all data used in training are owned by our clients.

- Notice and Explanation. CAI provides materials for educators and clients to understand how our models work, how they are combined with human scoring, and what percentage of responses are scored by AI and by human scorers. Methods for combining AI and human scoring are communicated with and approved by our clients. Any system changes are communicated as well.
- Human Alternatives, Considerations, and Fallback. Many of our clients offer avenues for educators to request rescores if they disagree with the score assigned to a student response.
